4. Amendment to clause 5 (Rule modifying the application of information privacy principles 12)

Clause 5(2)(a) is amended as follows:

Delete: section OD7 of the Income Tax Act 1994

Substitute: subpart YB of the Income Tax Act 2007

Note: This amendment substitutes a replacement Act for repealed legislation.
