1. What were the names of the two Boston lawyers, who later became US Supreme Court Justices, who wrote an article entitled The Right to Privacy in 1890, partly in response to the invention of "instantaneous photography"?

Samuel Warren and Louis Brandeis

2. What annual visitor to Otago finds itself under constant surveillance during its time onshore?

The Northern Royal Albatross or Toroa

3. Following on from 2019's The Great Hack, what 2020 Netflix documentary explores the 'dangerous human impact of social networking'?

The Social Dilemma

4. Which country has the heaviest CCTV surveillance in the world?

The People's Republic of China with <u>18 cities in the top 20 of most surveilled cities</u>.

5. What was the title of a 1998 surveillance-themed movie starring Will Smith?

<u>Enemy of the State - directed by Tony Scott.</u> The film is noteworthy for being ahead of its time in examining the issues of the US National Security Agency, which employed Edward Snowden, and privacy.

6. What's the name of the Office of the Privacy Commissioner's privacy breach reporting tool?

<u>NotifyUs</u>

7. There's a new principle 12 in the Privacy Act. What's it about?

Cross border disclosures of personal information

8. What is one big change in the Privacy Act 2020 that every organisation or business should be aware of?

Mandatory privacy breach notification

9. What is the slogan of the Privacy Commissioner's awareness campaign?

Privacy is precious



10. Approximately how many New Zealanders have downloaded the NZ COVID Tracer app to date?

Over 2.3 million

11. What privacy-loving marsupial has been credited with being accidental heroes for saving the lives of other Australian animals in the devastating bushfires last summer?

The wombat

12. What is the name of the contact tracing solution promoted by the entrepreneur Sam Morgan?

CovidCard

13. Can a business use the information in their Covid-19 contact tracing register to add to their mailing list?

No. The Privacy Act says information obtained for one purpose should not be used for any other reason (principle 10). The guest register should only be used for the public health reasons specified by the Ministry of Health.

14. What's the maximum fine that a business or organisation can face for the new criminal offences introduced in the Privacy Act 2020?

\$10,000

15. The Privacy Act 2020 contains more, fewer, or the same number of privacy principles than the 1993 Act?

This bit of a trick question. The answer is fewer. Although the information privacy principles have increased from 12 to 13, the <u>four public register privacy principles</u> have been repealed!
